The Council is anxious to promote rapid publication, and to this end has printed '*Notes for the guidance of authors*' (see *Proceedings*, vol. 30, No. 7), copies of which may be obtained from the Honorary Secretary (3d. post free). The Council strongly recommends to authors the directions given in the '*Notes*' as a means of reducing delays in the acceptance and printing of contributions.

Discussion: Members contributing to the discussion of papers read before the Society may submit an abstract of their remarks for publication in the *Proceedings*. Such contributions should be sent to the Editor immediately after the meeting.
